Reporting Worksheets



Using These Worksheets

The Australian Pesticides and Veterinary Medicines Authority (APVMA) has issued a permit to Grain Producers Australia (GPA) for the supply of certain mouse baits containing 50 g/kg zinc phosphide (Permit PER90799).

These worksheets have been put together to assist in the user reporting requirements under this permit.

The products covered under the permit are:

- 4 Farmers Zinc Phosphide 50g/Kg Unsterilized Mouse Bait Containing: 50 g/kg Zinc Phosphide as the only active constituent.
- 4 Farmers Zinc Phosphide Pellet Containing: 50 g/kg Zinc Phosphide as the only active constituent.
- Final Feast 50 Containing: 50 g/kg Zinc Phosphide as the only active constituent.
- Last Supper Supreme 50 Zinc Phosphide Mouse Bait Pellets Containing: 50 g/kg Zinc Phosphide as the only active constituent.
- Last Supper Supreme 50 Zinc Phosphide Mouse Bait Containing: 50 g/kg Zinc Phosphide as the only active constituent.
- Mice Terminator 50
 Containing: 50 g/kg Zinc Phosphide as the only active constituent.
- Mouseoff 50 Zinc Phosphide Bait Containing: 50 g/kg Zinc Phosphide as the only active constituent.
- Pestmaster Zinc Phosphide Mouse Killer Pellets
 Containing: 50 g/kg Zinc Phosphide as the only active constituent.
- SureFire 50 Zinc Phosphide Mouse Bait Pellets
 Containing: 50 g/kg Zinc Phosphide as the only active constituent.
- SureFire 50 Zinc Phosphide Mouse Bait Containing: 50 g/kg Zinc Phosphide as the only active constituent.

The permit requires that users of these products be authorised or licenced under the relevant state or territory poisons control for Schedule 7 Poisons.

Authorised users are required to keep records of intended use and actual use, and to report these in the GPA Training system.
